Essential operator in the oils and fats sector, our company asks all its suppliers and partners to work in the same environmental and societal approach. This is why, through our sourcing policy, we approve and support only suppliers and refiners who are actors and who commit for a sustainable supply chain of palm oil, including all stakeholders underlying in the field as the subsidiaries, mills, plantations...

A responsible sourcing includes the **environmental** (protection of forests, peatlands) and **societal** (human and community rights) aspects in full **transparency** at all levels of the supply chain :

ENVIRONMENTAL :

- No plantation development on High Carbon Stock (HCS) forests or High Conservation Value (HCV) areas respecting the Principles and Criteria of the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil (RSPO) and adopting the High Carbon Stock (HCS) approach.
- No plantation development on peatland regardless of depth.
- No burning.
- Implement programs to reduce greenhouse gas emissions (GHG).
- Plan procedures to manage complaints and all possible non conformities.

SOCIETAL :

- Respect internationally recognised human rights.
- Respect the rights of workers, of local populations and communities.
- Include consideration of local peoples and Free Prior Informed Consent (FPIC).
- Respect and protect the rights of children and their welfare.
- Help to incorporate smallholders into the supply chain.

TRANSPARENCY :

- Respect the RSPO guidelines and standard by an independent certification.
- Guarantee traceability of the certified palm oil to mills and work to improve traceability to plantation.
